If you can't find the pop-up, turn off the pop-up blocker of your PC (Allow pop-ups!).

) Choose the Global Network Track instead of the university track!

) Download university information and application forms (Global Network).

) Please complete the application documents and submit them by April 9th, 2026.

You must choose the Department of International Development and Cooperation only!

Please be advised that the final admission decision will be notified only after all required documents have been submitted and the online interview has been completed.

1. Selection Procedure

* TOEFL MyBestScores and iBT Home Edition scores are accepted. Test dates for all four sections of the applicant's MyBestScores report must be within valid date.

* Applicants from the following countries are exempt from submitting an English Proficiency Test score report: United States of America, United Kingdom, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Ireland, Republic of South Africa.

* Applicants who have completed their Bachelor's Degree from the following countries are exempt from submitting an English Proficiency Test score report: United States of America, United Kingdom, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Ireland, Republic of South Africa.

* Other matters regarding English proficiency test scores must meet requirements set forth by the Korean Immigration Regulations

- Required documents for relevant applicants: Published papers, Awards (officially attested), Submission of copied published papers and copied award certificate (officially attested), Adoption documents (only for overseas Korean adoptees)

○ Submission Method: Required documents should be submitted by post or in person(not by email) by the deadline.

○ Important notes regarding application submission

- Any additional documents required by each university/department must be submitted directly to the university.

- For applicants from countries that are parties to the Apostille Convention, all required documents must be submitted with an original Apostille. Applicants from non-member countries are to submit documents confirmed by the Korean Embassy.

- When original documents are written in a language other than English or Korean, applicants should submit the notarized and English translated version

- All documents must be submitted as original hard copies

2. Language Requirement
 - Graduate School: Eligible for application only if language requirement of each department is met
 - GSIS : Submission of Official Test of English is required (Above TOEFL-iBT 71 or IELTS 5.5)

○ Selection Procedure

- Document screening and interviews will be conducted for evaluation.
- Interviews can be omitted for those who failed in documents assessment
- Interviewees should be on designated time

○ Notes

- Selection for successful candidates will be done strictly by the NIIED Selection Committee.
- In case of submitting photocopied documents, applicants must submit the original to the 1st Selection Institution and have the original one and the photocopied one collated. The confirmation of collation should be indicated in the photocopied documents.
- Submitted documents WILL NOT BE RETURNED to the applicants whatsoever.
(If the original document cannot be reissued, you must submit a notarized copy certified as a true copy of the original.)
- Incomplete or incorrect documents may lead to application rejection or failure in the Selection Committee, and scholarship revocation even after entry into Korea.
- After the screening session, more documents can be additionally required.
- The applicant's English name and date of birth must match the information on his/her passport.
- All applicants must attend the interview on the designated day.
